Prepare Lodge & base area for opening (shovel porches, vacuum, organize rental shop equipment); manage parking lot to maximize customer parking & safety; prepare bus loading & rope tow areas for operation (complete daily checklist); scan each customer for valid day ticket or season pass; operate rope tow. Assist guests through rental process, ensuring all equipment is adjusted for the specific renter utilizing industry standards; provide instruction on equipment use & guest's responsibility; ensure completion of all forms & that waivers are signed; receive, inspect & document rental returns; POS sales; maintain a clean & safe working environment; Obtain Ski Binding Certifications to test ski bindings; end of day duties & lodge clean up as assigned.

- Computer proficiency & ability to operate a point-of-sale/cash register & to use small tools.
