About the job

We are looking for dependable, upbeat team members who enjoy working with people and are comfortable working both indoors and outside in Fairbanks winter weather. This is a hands-on position with a mix of POS retail, rental-shop work, ticket checking, rope-tow operation, cleaning, and opening/closing duties.

What you'll do

- Prepare the lodge and base area for opening: shovel porches, vacuum, organize rental equipment, and complete opening tasks.
- Manage the parking lot to maximize customer parking and maintain safe traffic flow.
- Prepare bus-loading and rope-tow areas for operation and complete the daily Rope Tow checklist.
- Check each customer for a valid day ticket or season pass, assist with bus loading and operate the rope tow.
- Help guests through the rental process; adjust equipment for each renter using industry standards and explain equipment use and guest responsibilities.
- Make sure required forms are completed and waivers are signed; receive, inspect, and document rental returns.
- Handle POS/cash-register sales and help keep the lodge and work areas clean, organized, and safe.
- Obtain Ski Binding Certifications and perform ski-binding testing as trained.
- Complete end-of-day lodge and base-area duties as assigned.

What we're looking for

- 18 years of age or older.
- Committed, reliable, and able to get to Moose Mountain dependably in winter conditions.
- Comfortable using a computer/POS system, small hand tools, cleaning supplies & snow shovels.
- Friendly, cheerful, and professional with guests, coworkers, and management.
- Able to stay calm, helpful, and flexible when the lodge is busy.
- Skiing or snowboarding experience is helpful—but not required. We will train you.

Physical & winter-work requirements

- Able to lift up to 35 lbs., bend, stoop, walk, shovel snow, and push or pull equipment.
- Able to stand for extended periods, both indoors and outdoors.
- Some duties involve extended periods of binding adjustment using a screwdriver.
- Regular exposure to Fairbanks winter weather is part of the job.
